

The Logan County Department of Job & Family Services (LCDJFS) will make Sub-Recipient Agreements for Domestic Violence Services utilizing Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) funds. The LCDJFS will make agreements through a request for proposals process (RFP) to responsible persons or agencies whose proposals are most advantageous to the service, with unit cost, unit reimbursement rate and other factors considered.

Logan County Domestic Violence Program – Services or activities that implement and provide programs to promote employability and stable families. Vendor shall offer programs and services aimed at reducing the incidence of domestic violence through assessment, treatment and counseling of both the victims of abuse and their batterers.

The contract will be for a period of one year with the ability to negotiate an additional one year term without the release of another RFP.
