

The Logan County Department of Job & Family Services (LCDJFS) will make Purchase of Social Services Agreements for Substance Abuse Services utilizing Federal Title XX Block Grant funds. The LCDJFS will make agreements through a request for proposals process (RFP) to responsible persons or agencies whose proposals are most advantageous to the service, with unit cost, unit reimbursement rate and other factors considered.

Substance Abuse Services – Services or activities that are primarily designed to deter, reduce, or eliminate substance abuse or chemical dependency. Except for initial detoxification services, medical and residential services may be included but only as an integral but subordinate part of the service. Component substance abuse services or activities may include a comprehensive range of personal and family counseling methods, methadone treatment for opiate abusers, or detoxification treatment for alcohol abusers. Services may be provided in alternative living arrangements such as institutional settings and community-based halfway houses.

All Purchase of Social Services Agreements must have seventeen percent (17%) state or local matching funds, secured by the provider agency. The total dollar value of the agreement will be a total of the federal and matching funds. The contract will be for a period of one year with the ability to negotiate an additional one year term without the release of another RFP.
